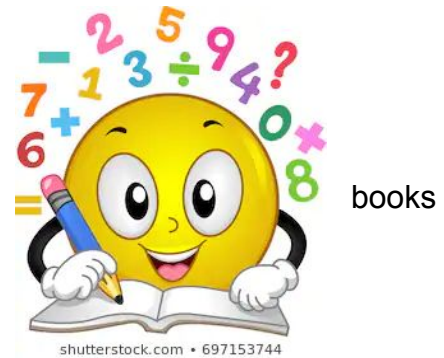
LITERACY and SESE

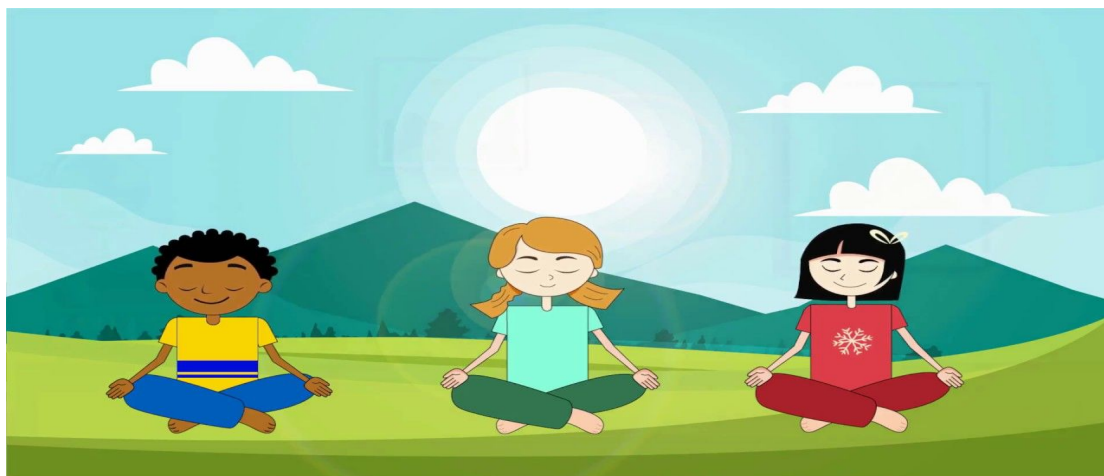
