



Covid-19 Summary for Parents

This is a short summary of our plan for reopening

There will be a staggered arrival and departure system in place from 8.50 a.m. See Parents Letter on website for timings. Siblings may arrive/depart together.

Parents are asked not to gather in Deverell Place



To pick up a child during school hours, you must phone first.

There will be no access to the school building for parents or visitors, bar exceptional circumstances.

All staff will complete COVID induction training.

We will try to get outdoors as much as possible. Children should wear coats.

As per current guidelines, all staff will wear a mask when it is not possible to keep physical distance.

Pupils and staff will wash/sanitise their hands regularly, using proper technique.

Everyone will use the hand sanitiser provided on entry and exit

Pupils must be kept home with high temperature, cough, breathing difficulties or loss of taste or smell. Pupils should also be kept home if generally unwell.

Classrooms will be cleaned daily in line with Department of Education guidelines. There will be a cleaner on site during the school day cleaning frequently touched surfaces and toilet areas.

Pupils should stay home for 14 days after returning from a country not on the green list.

If showing symptoms, pupil will be isolated and parents called.

Parents should contact their doctor.

Each class will operate as a 'bubble'. 4-6 children within each class will operate as a 'pod'. 'Pods' will be kept at least 1m apart in classrooms.

Physical distancing will be implemented where practical for children.

All pupils should have their own pencil case with .pencils, colours, parer, rubber, glue stick.

Shared resources will be wiped down at the end of the day.
